Qualifications

1). Academic Entry Requirement

At least one of the following criteria must be met:

- Completed Upper Secondary or its equivalent as recognized by 1. the Thai Ministry of Education or
- Completed High School Grade 12 in the US system or completed General Education Development (GED); or
- Passed 3 International Cambridge A/AS Level Subjects Grade C or higher in British system; or
- Completed International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma; or
- Passed the Global Assessment Certificate (GAC) test

2). English Language Requirement

At least one of the following criteria must be met:

- English is the applicant's first language; or
- IELTS (Academic) overall score of 5.0; or
- TOEFL score of 500 in Paper-Based Test / 173 in Computer-Based Test / 59 in Internet-Based Test; or
- Cambridge First Certificate; or
- CU-TEP Test equivalent score of 60; or
- Passed Rangsit University's English Placement Test (CEFR level B2); or
- Satisfactory completion of Rangsit University's English Foundation Program.

(If you do not have any English test listed above, you can take an English Proficiency Exam or English Placement Test at the International Student Admission Office, International College, Rangsit University)
